Flying Members

The “flying member” status is for those who want to fly club planes. This includes those wanting to train for their pilot certificate as well as those that already hold a private pilot certificate and just wish to fly. Flying members pay a small entry fee, and then monthly dues of just \$25 to offset fixed expenses, such as hanger fees and insurance. Flying members are provided access to plane keys, fuel cards and access to an [online scheduler](#) to reserve up to 8 hours of time.

Initial fees break down this way:

Persons interested in becoming a flying member must also complete an application to fly the plane(s) owned or managed by the club. This new form also covers those wanting to fly the Brock owned Cessna 150 & 172SP.

Introductory Members

Not sure if you want to commit to becoming a flying member, but want to experience what it's like to fly? No problem. The Club has created an introductory membership which allows you to experience flight without needing to join as a full, flying member. Introductory members can fly up to 2 hours within one month's time, and only need to pay for the cost of the plane rental (which starts at \$150 per hour) and their instructor (starting at ~\$50 per hour).
